RESOLUTION BY COMMISSIONER TANIS

WHEREAS, under the Emergency 9-1-1 Service Enabling Act (P.A. 32 of 1986, as amended), the Kent County Board of Commissioners approved the final 911 service plan on February 4, 1987 to benefit the citizens of Kent County by providing a uniform and well known emergency telephone number; and

WHEREAS, the Kent County Board of Commissioners continues to believe that 911 service will benefit the citizens of Kent County; and

WHEREAS, the State of Michigan enacted Public Act 164 of 2007 to further support 9-1-1 service in Michigan; and

WHEREAS, Kent County has deemed it necessary to collect county-based 9-1-1 funds from communications service providers as allowed under Public Act 164 of 2007 to defray the costs of being ready to process, and of actually processing 9-1-1 calls placed within Kent County; and

WHEREAS, Public Act 164 of 2007 allows for limited amendments to be made to the Kent County 9-1-1 Plan through resolution by the County Board of Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kent County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts this amendment to the Kent County 9-1-1 Plan to establish a monthly county-based 9-1-1 surcharge as permitted under P.A. 164 of 2007.

Commissioner Tanis moved the resolution be adopted.
